Methodology Workshops in our school-November 14, 2009

In response to the opinions and comments of the parents of our students, we are slightly changing our school's philosophy. Over 80% of our students were born in the U.S.A., or came to this country at a very young age, for this reason we should treat Polish as a second language for them. Polish is their family and native language, however it is much more difficult for them to speak in Polish than in English bearing in mind that they are living in the U.S.A. and English is their primary form of communication. For this reason, we have invited special guests to our school, Dr. Agnieszka Rabiej, who **specializes in teaching Polish as a second language**, and Dr. Piotr Rabiej, from the history department of the Jagiellonian University in Krakow. The main topics of the workshop were: "Methods and techniques for teaching Polish as a second language" as well as "Integrated teaching in a language school - language, history and geography". Our school opened its doors to all teachers who were interested in raising their skills and knowledge of these topics. In total, 37 teachers from the Chicago-land area, Indiana, and Wisconsin participated in the workshops. The lessons lasted 6 hours. Dr. Rabiej shared the latest trends in teaching Polish in early education. Thanks to these workshops, our school received very valuable knowledge and skills for our teachers and at the same time did not bear any financial costs for the workshops.
